The Beatles recorded their first album at the Abbey Road Studios in London. It was called Please Please Me and every song on the album went to number one.

During the 1960s, the Beatles went on tour several times. Some of the countries they visited were the USA, Denmark, Hong Kong, New Zealand, and Australia. The band was very popular, but in 1970 they stopped making music together.
