**MUNICH**

Munich is the capital of Bavaria, in the southwest of Germany. It is famous for its beer, white sausages and great quality of life. Find out a little bit more about the city with our special 'city in numbers' guide.

- It's the 3rd largest city in Germany and the <sup>1</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ biggest city population in the EU. It has 1.3 million inhabitants.
- It has 70 million visitors every year and it's the most popular tourist city in Germany.
